GOSPEL REFLECTION

Against All Forms of Idolatry - To explain idolatry, let me use an illustration. I did not invent it. It comes from St. Augustine. He uses the example of a girl whose fiancé gives her an engagement ring. The ring is gorgeous and the boy is happy that his girl likes it so much. She of course is dying to show it to her friends. Well, she starts to love the ring so much that it becomes more important to her than the one who gave it! When the boy discovers that his girl loves the ring more than him, he is not so happy. And if he finds out she is using the ring to make her girl friends envious and show her superiority over them, he might be more than unhappy. He might become furious. "I gave you the ring as a sign of our love - not to look down on others."

St. Augustine says that something similar applies to our relationship with God. He has given us gifts, tokens of his love. For sure, He wants us to love his gifts and to be grateful for them. He does not give the gifts, however, for their own sake - or to make us think we are better than others. Like an engagement ring, he wants the gifts to signify a relationship - and to lead us to him. Anything less involves some degree of idolatry. (Fr. Phil Bloom)

MEDITAZIONE SPIRITUALE

Il Servizio Incombente - La spiritualità farisaica è contraddittoria. Da una parte austera, rigida, severa, dall'altra superficiale, esteriore, vuota. Maestri esigenti, duri con i propri discepoli, gli scribi e i farisei sono accondiscendenti, miti con se stessi. Interpretano severamente i precetti della legge quando riguardano gli altri, li svigoriscono con le loro disquisizioni se toccano essi stessi.

Tutto il loro sforzo si esaurisce in impegni secondari e inutili. In pratica ingrandiscono gli astucci (le filatterie) in cui sono contenuti i brani di pergamena con testi della legge, e allungano le frange dei mantelli. Erano due segni che ricordavano la cura e l'attenzione verso la legge (cfr. Dt 22,12), ma lo ricordavano più di tutto agli altri, che li designavano con il nome di «osservanti».

La spiritualità farisaica è esibizionistica per questo affetta di esteriorismo, motivata da vanagloria e orgoglio: una tentazione allettante. In un mondo in cui la religiosità è tenuta in considerazione le persone pie sono spesso considerate come le più vicine a Dio e quindi degne del più grande amore. Per questo i farisei usufruivano dei primi posti nelle feste di famiglia (nei conviti), nella sinagoga (dove occupavano le prime file) e nella società, dove udivano risuonare i loro nomi con i rispettivi titoli.

L'evangelista parla dei farisei ma ai cristiani («tra voi»), addirittura alle guide della comunità. Anch'esse sembrano affette dalla stessa malattia. Il perentorio «non fatevi chiamare» denota quanto la situazione sia grave. I titoli di «maestro», «padre» (o capo), «guida» sono indebiti perché i cristiani sono tutti «fratelli», figli dello stesso «Padre», che li assiste mediante il suo Spirito (cfr. 12,30-31; 28,19).
