GOSPEL REFLECTION

Give her something to eat - In today's gospel, Mark's lean, spare, almost journalistic prose tells the story of not one but two miracles of healing, the first being the woman who for twelve years suffered from hemorrhages and is broke from all the doctors. She is cured when she just touches the hem of Jesus's garment, and, when she collapses in fear, he tells her that it was her faith that cured her. He then is brought to the house of Jairus the synagogue official, whose young daughter has just died. If Jesus is greeted with fear in the first healing, the second one brings him scorn and derisive laughter. The grown woman falls down in fear, the little girl reclines in the slumber of death. Both are raised up by Jesus before the story ends with a meal. (Joseph Malham)

A Mystery of Faith - Scripture tells us that faith is "the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). The Eucharist is certainly a mystery of faith and cannot be grasped by our limited human understanding. Accepting Jesus' command to "Do this in memory of me", requires us to deny our

senses and humbly submit to His instruction. What better advice can we be given than the words of Mary at the wedding feast of Cana when she stated, "Do whatever He tells you" (John 2:5)? Just as He changed water into wine, He can turn ordinary bread and wine into His Body and Blood. By listening to Mary's advice, we can accept (without fully understanding) the miracle that occurs on the altar and embrace Our Lord's words, "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life" (John 6:54). Questa donna, devastata dalla malattia che la rendeva impura e reietta alla stregua dei lebbrosi, con la sua caparbietà infrange le regole imposte dalla tradizione a rischio della propria vita e tocca Gesù. Giairo, a discapito della sua dignità come capo della sinagoga, si inginocchia davanti a colui che la sua religione condannava come ribelle e blasfemo, e implora aiuto per la guarigione di sua figlia.

Si tratta di incontri che cambiano la vita. Possiamo passare accanto a numerose persone nella nostra vita, ma senza incontrarle mai. L'incontro avviene quando si abbassano le proprie difese, le proprie chiusure e ci si lascia invadere da un'alterità che ci apre all'infinito, ci eleva al livello più alto del nostro sé e ci fa esistere: noi esistiamo in quanto incontriamo (come sostiene il filosofo francese François Jullien). In una società interconnessa come la nostra gli incontri veri però sono rari. Gli incontri veri sono quelli che comportano l'incontro faccia-faccia e permettono all'altro di entrare nella propria intimità. Gesù dopo essersi sentito toccato, vuole vedere faccia a faccia chi lo ha toccato, entrare nella sua intimità. Guardando negli occhi la donna le dice: «Figlia, la tua fede ti ha salvata. Va' in pace e sii guarita dal tuo male». Gesù guarisce non solo il corpo ma anche l'anima. A Giairo che ha lasciato tutte le sue remore e va incontro a Gesù si sente dire: «Non temere, soltanto abbi fede!».
