#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Gospel Background - Today's Gospel begins with a report that the Jews complained about Jesus' claims regarding his identity. They knew his family, and they knew he was the son of Joseph. They could not comprehend what Jesus meant when he said that he came down from heaven. Jesus responds to the complaints by saying that only those who are chosen by God will recognize him as the one that God sent. This is a recurring theme in John's Gospel, that God has chosen those who will have faith in Jesus.

In today's reading, we hear Jesus say again, as he did in last week's Gospel, that he is the bread of life. We also hear Jesus add that he is the living bread. Both of these statements help us understand better the gift that Jesus gives us in the Eucharist. We celebrate this gift of Jesus each time we gather for Mass. We believe that receiving Jesus in the Eucharist will lead us to eternal life. (Sunday Connection LoyolaPress)

No Jesus without Mary ... - In the life of the Dominican friar, St. Hyacinth, we read that once in order to avoid a profanation of the Blessed Sacrament, the Saint hastened to the tabernacle to take out the ciborium containing the sacred Particles, in order to put it in a safer place. When, hugging Jesus in the Eucharist close to his breast, he was about to leave the altar, he heard a voice coming from the statue of the Blessed


Virgin which was next to the altar, saying, "What? Would you take Jesus away without taking me?" The Saint halted in surprise. He understood the message, but he did not know how he could manage to carry Mary's statue too. Puzzled, he drew near the statue to see if he could take it with his one free hand. There was no need to strain himself, for the statue became as light as a feather. There is a precious lesson in this miracle: When we take Mary along with Jesus, she adds absolutely no weight or cost, for in a wonderful way they abide in one another (John 6:57).

It provides the ritual actions for all the stages of initiation as well as, guides those who might not participate in the full Rite, but who are not yet in full communion with the Church.

#### **REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATES**

Due to the high volume of requests for Baptism, Confirmation & Marriage certificates, our parish office will only be issuing the document(s) on 15<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> day of each month.

A certificate will only be given to someone authorized to have it. Authorized persons include:

- the individual named in the record
- parents or legal guardians of an individual under the age of 18 (if the parent is named on the individual's birth certificate or other legal documents)
- legally authorized representatives acting on behalf of an individual
- next-of-kin, executor or estate administrator of a deceased individual
- Catholic parishes or agencies such as Catholic Children's Aid Society.

#### **PICKING-UP COPIES OF CERTIFICATES**

The individual authorized to receive the record should come in person to the parish office and present proper photo identification to pick up their certificate. Examples of photo identification include driver's licence, passport, etc.

If the person does not live near the parish and is unable to pick up their certificate from the parish of issue, one of the following two options are to be considered:

- if the certificate is required for admission to a Catholic school, or for the reception of a sacrament at another parish, the certificate can be mailed directly by the issuing parish to the school or the parish where the sacrament is to be administered,
- if the certificate is required for any other purpose, it can be mailed by the issuing parish to the individual's parish of domicile where he or she may pick it up after presenting proof of identity. If mailing a certificate to a parish outside of the Archdiocese of Toronto, we will notify the other parish about our policy of requiring photo identification.
