GOSPEL REFLECTION

Bread from heaven to eat - Jesus does not rebuke His audience for seeking "free bread," but rather for working for bread that does not last. Jesus is offering to give them free bread forever, but it is a very different kind of "bread." As usual in the Gospel of John, our Lord's words are not understood correctly. They think that Jesus is encouraging them to accomplish some work that will please God, and thus they can earn eternal life. So they ask, "What must we do to accomplish the deeds God requires?" Their question is a reflection of their distorted interpretation and application of the Old Testament law. They think the law spells out what God requires of them, so that through lawkeeping they can earn His favor. They are wrong. For through the law comes the knowledge of sin. But now apart from the law the righteousness of God, which is attested by the law and the prophets, has been disclosed namely, the righteousness of God through the faithfulness of Jesus Christ for all who believe. This work consisted in loving and adoring Jesus as Her Son and as Her God. — Jesus became a child in order to invite us, with His love and charm, to the love of God.

REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATES

Due to the high volume of requests for Baptism, Confirmation & Marriage certificates, our parish office will only be issuing the document(s) on 15th & 30th day of each month.

A certificate will only be given to someone authorized to have it. Authorized persons include:

- the individual named in the record;
- parents or legal guardians of an individual under the age of 18 (if the parent is named on the individual's birth certificate or other legal documents);
- legally authorized representatives acting on behalf of an individual;
- next-of-kin, executor or estate administrator of a deceased individual; and
- Catholic parishes or agencies such as Catholic Children's Aid Society.

PICKING-UP COPIES OF CERTIFICATES

The individual authorized to receive the record should come in person to the parish office and present proper photo identification to pick up their certificate. Examples of photo identification include driver's licence, passport, etc.

If the person does not live near the parish and is unable to pick up their certificate from the parish of issue, one of the following two options are to be considered:

- if the certificate is required for admission to a Catholic school, or for the reception of a sacrament at another parish, the certificate can be mailed directly by the issuing parish to the school or the parish where the sacrament is to be administered,
- if the certificate is required for any other purpose, it can be mailed by the issuing parish to the individual's parish of domicile where he or she may pick it up after presenting proof of identity. If mailing a certificate to a parish outside of the Archdiocese of Toronto, we will notify the other parish about our policy of requiring photo identification.
