THE GOSPEL BACKGROUND

The power of Jesus' name - In today's gospel, the disciples observed that the unknown exorcist invoked Jesus' name and was successful in his healing efforts. This unknown healer recognized the power of Jesus' name, yet he was not a follower of Jesus. In his reply to his disciples, Jesus acknowledges that deeds of faith can precede the words of faith. He also teaches that the disciples should not be reluctant to share Jesus' healing powers with others.

Later in this Gospel, Jesus teaches us not to create obstacles for those who are just beginning to have faith but to encourage even the smallest signs of faith. The Greek word used here for sin also connotes "stumbling" or "causing scandal." In vivid terms Jesus teaches his disciples the consequences to those who would put obstacles before people who are on the road to faith. (Sunday Connection Loyola Press)

OUR LADY OF THE EUCHARIST



Ask yourself: who gave us the gift of the Incarnation? It was the Eternal Father, but through Mary... Jesus was incarnate and was born, but through Mary... It was She who gave Jesus to the world... Thus, if the Eucharist is the continuation of the Incarnation, it is very clear that the Eucharist is the continuation of the gift from Mary. — She continues to give Jesus to us

daily, just like how She gave Him to us at the stable in Bethlehem. — Adam lost everything for us by eating of the fruit that the woman gave him. "The woman that you gave me as a companion has given me the fruit and I have eaten it..." So, Adam sinned... Likewise, we can say, "Lord, the woman, whom you gave to us as a Mother, has given to us and is giving to us, the blessed fruit of Her womb, and so we live... through Him who nourishes us." 2025 SACRAMENTS
