EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

A star guided the Magi to Bethlehem so that there they could discover "the king of the Jews who was born" and worship him. Matthew adds in his Gospel: "When they entered the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him". The journey from the East, the search, the star that appeared to the Magi, the sight of the Savior and his adoration constitute the stages that peoples and individuals had to go through in their journey to meet the Savior of the world. The light and its call are not things of the past, since the history of the faith of each of us refers to them. In order for them to experience the joy of seeing Christ, of adoring him and of offering him their gifts, the Magi went through situations in which they always had to ask, always follow the sign sent to them by God.

MARY, THREE KINGS, AND THREE HERODS

What is "Mary's side," and what is "the epic struggle?" The struggle is the battle between good and evil. "Mary's side" seeks to protect the life of her Son against the Herods of the world, who - threatened by perfect goodness - wish to slay the essence of incarnated Love.

The three kings counterbalance the three Herods. Yes, the New Testament speaks of a trio of men who bore that name. The first, Herod the Great, is the one in the Epiphany story. He slaughtered the innocents. His son, Herod Antipas, succeeded him and had Mary's nephew, John the Baptist, beheaded. The third Herod, Herod Agrippa, martyred St. James and imprisoned St. Peter. Fortunately, Mary's husband, Joseph, and the Magi were good men. They were warned by angels about Herod the Great's treachery. These are the men of "Mary's side." They hear the word of God and follow its instruction. Herod hears of a king being born but fails to grasp the significance. He conceives of the Messiah as a rival for the kingship of Judea. He misses the point. The Magi and Joseph are on Mary's side. So are we.
