SIXTH SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME YEAR C

In the Gospel of Luke, the Beatitudes are addressed to those who have already chosen the Lord, to the disciples. Following him means abandoning everything, renouncing comforts, being detested, distancing oneself from the circles of power, money and honor. The believer who succeeds everywhere, who receives respect and consideration from the world, should tremble, be worried because he will be swallowed up and digested by the world he loves to possess. It is not a question of demagogy or fear of life. Jesus is not a learned professor of ethics, nor a systematic author of treatises on morality. His preaching is a prophetic denunciation: short sentences and strong contrasts. The Beatitudes warn us seriously: let us establish ourselves in the truth of Jesus and try not to make mistakes at the decisive moment.

MARY AND THE BEATITUDES

Mary accompanies us, let us allow her to show us what it truly means to follow Christ: to believe in him; to trust him, to love him. For the Church has always recognized Mary as the Lord's first and best disciple. Even before Jesus was born, Mary lived in the spirit of the Beatitudes: she, who was poor, lowly and pure of heart, was fashioned by the Holy Spirit as the tabernacle of the Divine Savior. As the events in the life of Christ unfolded, Mary carefully retained them in her heart and pondered their meaning. Jesus' words, "Blessed are they who hear the Word of God and keep it" (Lk 11:28) apply preeminently to Mary. Walking with our Blessed Mother we learn how to pray, how to open our heart to Jesus, how to trust in his promises, and how to bear him witness by a life of goodness and charity. https://catholicreview.org/an-inward-pilgrimage-with-mary/
