Before being the rock on which Christ would found his Church, Simon-Peter was the one who walked the entire path full of impulsive passion and at the same time of uncertainties towards his Lord. In this way, he was the one who walked, before us, the itinerary that each of us is asked to walk.

Simon was a fisherman: each has his own job and each of us can find ourselves toiling in the darkness of many nights and catching nothing. But that Presence intervenes and asks us to work on his word, that is, to live our existence within that powerful event that is Christ the Lord and then our work and our existence find a fruitfulness never known before.

MARY TEACH US TRUST

No one can teach us more about trust than Mary. She, too, had to learn to trust the Lord. Her fiat came out of faith and trust in who she knew God the Father to be, but her life from that moment forward was one of constant occasions to trust God more. She had to trust that Joseph wouldn't leave her; she had to trust that God was still Love when she was misunderstood and maligned by friends and loved ones. She had to trust God with her loneliness when she fled to Egypt, and she had to trust for decades as Jesus grew and remained a simple carpenter in her home. And then there is the trust she must have had to see her only son falsely accused, brutally beaten, and crucified. She had to continue to trust the Father as her son remained dead, while she went home without him. Our Blessed Mother reminds us that there is no darkness her son cannot overcome.
