ASCENSION OF THE LORD (YEAR C)

The death of Jesus was a scandal for his disciples, because they had fashioned for themselves a Christ without a cross. But Jesus of Nazareth is the Messiah; and there is no other Messiah than the crucified and glorified one. It is through the catechesis of the Lord, risen, that the disciples understand that the Messiah had to suffer and rise from the dead. The meaning of the cross and of accompanying the disciples on the cross clashes with the intelligence, the heart and the plans of man. In order for the disciples to be the authorized witnesses of Jesus Christ, they must not only understand his redemptive death but also receive the Holy Spirit. Jesus separates from the disciples, blessing them and entrusting them to the protection of God the Father. The Lord's Ascension into heaven and the sending of the Holy Spirit, to make the disciples courageous witnesses and to accompany them until the return of Jesus, are closely linked.

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD AND THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY

While Jesus and Mary both enter heaven miraculously, only one does so on their own power. Just as Jesus descends from heaven in the incarnation, he returns to heaven in the ascension. Jesus, true God and true human, ascends on his own power. Mary, on the other hand, has no ability to rise into heaven on her own. Mary is venerated by the church as the Queen of Heaven and Earth and the greatest of the saints. Like us, however, she is fully human. Mary is not God: She is assumed into heaven by God.

Both events, though, tell us the same story. Mary's assumption is only possible and only makes sense in light of Jesus' ascension. By ascending into heaven, Jesus, as he does in the resurrection, defeats death and provides a new way for his followers. Mary, the first disciple of Jesus, shows us how a life lived in conformity with God's will, should end: by entering, body and soul, into perfect communion with God. https://uscatholic.org/articles


