### XVI SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C)

The biblical texts of this Sunday teach us that the triune God loves to visit humanity from time to time, because his presence grants honor and blessing. In the time of the patriarchs, he visits Abraham and promises a son to Sarah, who as yet had no child. Jesus, for his part, extols two unmarried women, Mary and Martha, honoring them with his visit and his word. The account of this visit shows us that true respect must be shown to Jesus. The triune God of the Trinity continues to visit humanity today. Often, we only realize God's coming after his visit. On this day, our Lord and Savior invites us to come to him. He is the priest, the herald, and the host of this liturgical feast. Let us rejoice in this honor, listen attentively to his word, and celebrate today's communion with him with an attitude of veneration.

#### **MARY & THE WORD OF GOD**

The Virgin Mary is closely linked to the Word of Jesus, as she was chosen by God to be the mother of his incarnate Son, Jesus Christ. Mary welcomed the Word of God into her womb and gave birth to the Word made flesh, thus becoming the "Theotokos," the bearer of God. Her faith and obedience enabled the fulfillment of God's plan of salvation.

In the Annunciation: The angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she would conceive by the power of the Holy Spirit and give birth to the Son of God, whom she named Jesus. Concerning her Faith and obedience, she accepted the role God had entrusted to her with humility and faith, pronouncing her "yes" (fiat) to the angel. In the Incarnation, she carried and gave birth to Jesus, the Word of God made flesh, thus bringing about the Incarnation. As Mother of God:

Mary is venerated as the Mother of God (Theotokos) in the Christian tradition for her unique role in the Incarnation.

At the end, Mary is a model of faith and obedience for all Christians, who are called to follow her example in embracing the Word of God in their lives. https://www.vatican.va/roman\_curia/synod
