XXV SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C)

The parable, obviously, praises the steward not because he is dishonest, but because he has the clarity and resolve to take the only path to salvation open to him. We know that the art of getting by is widely applied in the ambiguous undertakings of this world. It is much less so in the great undertaking of eternal salvation. Therefore, Jesus reproaches us for being more ready to save ourselves from worldly evils than from eternal evil. A decisive "test" of the authenticity of our Christian resolve is precisely the use of money. Wealth in itself is not dishonest, nor is external wealth a curse. But wealth as an idol, a passion, and a project, which desire at all costs is dishonest. We must make a choice: either mammon or God; There is only one way to free ourselves from the slavery of wealth: to make "friends" through what we have, through the commitment to sharing in solidarity.

OUR LADY VS THE DISHONEST STEWARD

A moral comparison between the virgin Mary and the dishonest steward in the parable in Luke 16:1-8, highlights a comparison and a teaching lesson. Jesus contrasts the shrewd, worldly wisdom of the steward with the spiritual wisdom and commitment of the faithful, exemplified by Mary. The dishonest steward's self-serving actions, though prudent in a worldly sense, are contrasted with the self-giving faithfulness that truly pleases God, a path exemplified by Our Lady.
