"Your faith has saved you." The Samaritan leper, the only stranger in the group who approached Jesus to plead with him. He was also the only one to retrace his steps to give thanks. His religious gesture, prostrating himself at Jesus' feet, also signified that he knew he had nothing he had not received (cf. 1 Cor 4:7). "And the other nine, where are they?" The other nine had obeyed Jesus' command and presented themselves to the priests, thus demonstrating their nascent faith. But they did not act accordingly, once purified, returning to Jesus, the only way to the Father (cf. Jn 14:6), the indispensable mediator for the glorification of God.

Jesus' mercy toward one who possesses nothing but his poverty and sin, but who turns to the Lord to find forgiveness and reconciliation, is not only a source of personal salvation, but also of reintegration into the worshipping community of God's people.

MARY, WOMAN OF FAITH

Over the centuries, many titles have been given to describe Mary's role in Christianity. In recent decades, the titles "Woman of Faith" and "Model Disciple" have been used a lot. Mary is called "Woman of Faith" because in and through all the trials of life, she never doubted God. She trusted that God would be faithful to her. At the Annunciation, Mary was called to trust that she would conceive a child through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Church also presents Mary to us as Model Disciple because she was open and responsive to God's plan. It has been well said that long before Mary conceived Jesus in her womb, she had conceived him in her heart. Mary is Model Disciple because she trusted God when it was not easy to do so. When nearly all of Jesus' disciples had fled in fear, Mary remained faithful to him all the way to Calvary.


