XXVII DOMENICA DEL TEMPO ORDINARIO (ANNO C)

È un male molto diffuso tra i credenti quello di considerare la fede come un atteggiamento puramente intellettuale, come la semplice accettazione di alcune verità. Cioè, una fede che si traduce in una presa di posizione teorica, senza una vera incidenza sulla vita. Questo squilibrio ha come conseguenza lo scandalo della croce: l'esitazione davanti alle difficoltà che incontriamo ogni giorno e che sono sovente insormontabili se noi non siamo abbastanza radicati in Dio. Allora ci rivoltiamo con la stessa reazione insolente e insultante. Le due brevi parabole del testo evangelico ricordano due proprietà della fede: l'intensità e la gratuità. Per mettere in rilievo il valore di una fede minima, ma solida, Cristo insiste sugli effetti che può produrre: cambiare di posto anche all'albero più profondamente radicato. Per insistere sulla fede come dono di Dio, porta l'esempio del servitore che pone il servizio del suo amore prima di provvedere ai suoi propri bisogni. È l'esigenza del servizio del Vangelo che ci ricorda san Paolo (1Tm 1,1), ma questo stesso apostolo ci avverte che "i lavori penosi" trovano sempre l'appoggio della grazia di Dio.

XXVII SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C)

It is a widespread evil among believers to view faith as a purely intellectual attitude, as the simple acceptance of certain truths. That is, a faith that translates into a theoretical stance, without any real impact on life. This imbalance results in the scandal of the cross: hesitation in the face of the difficulties we encounter every day, which are often insurmountable if we are not sufficiently rooted in God. Then we rebel with the same insolent and insulting reaction. The two brief parables in the Gospel text recall two properties of faith: intensity and generosity. To highlight the value of a minimal but solid faith, Christ emphasizes the effects it can produce: changing the position of even the most deeply rooted tree. To emphasize faith as a gift from God, he offers the example of the servant who places the service of his love before providing for his own needs. It is the need for service to the Gospel that St. Paul reminds us of (1 Tim 1:1), but this same apostle warns us that "hard work" always finds support in the grace of God.


