MARY AND THE HUMAN DRAMA OF DEATH

The concepts of the Virgin Mary's death are centered on the Dormition (falling asleep) & Assumption into heaven. Christian tradition, particularly in the Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches, holds that Mary died a natural death, her soul was taken by Christ, her body was resurrected, and then she was taken bodily into heaven. The experience of death personally enriched the Blessed Virgin: by undergoing mankind's common destiny, she can more effectively exercise her spiritual motherhood towards those approaching the last moment of their life.
