FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT YEAR A

The Gospel according to St. Matthew begins with the "genealogy of Jesus Christ" (Mt 1:1-17).

The evangelist thus emphasizes that the story that God began with Abraham has now reached its goal in Jesus Christ. The goal is not the end of history, since it continues, but in a new way. The passage from today's Gospel that speaks of the "birth of Jesus Christ" shows us just how new this story is. St. Matthew uses this word here, which can mean anything: genesis, origin, source, existence, becoming. The complete renewal is already being prepared in verse 16, which says: "Joseph, the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born." It is therefore clear that St. Matthew means that Joseph was none other than Jesus' adoptive father.

MARY AND GENEALOGY OF JESUS

Matthew's Gospel (Chapter 1) provides Jesus' genealogy through Joseph's line, tracing back to Abraham via King David and Solomon, naming Jacob as Joseph's father, but notably includes five women (Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, Bathsheba, and Mary) in an unusual way, emphasizing Jesus' connection to both Jewish history (David) and the wider world. Luke's Gospel offers a different genealogy, tracing through Mary's line (Joseph's father-in-law, Eli) back to Adam, highlighting Jesus' universal role, with both genealogies converging on Jesus' Davidic descent as Messiah, fulfilling prophecy.
